# INVITATION TO TENDER FOR THE DARTMOOR FOREST (PRINCETOWN AND POSTBRIDGE) COMBINED GRASS CUTTING CONTRACT FOR THE PERIOD 1 JUNE 2014 – 31 MARCH 2017.

### Introduction

Dartmoor Forest Parish Council, in Partnership with the Duchy of Cornwall, St Michael and All Angels Church and, potentially from 2015, the Dartmoor National Park Authority, is inviting tenders for a combined grass cutting contract for Princetown and Postbridge.

Although all Partners will use the single combined contract for grass cutting services, current funding arrangements will require the contractor to submit separate invoices for each of 3 groups of areas.

The Parish Council is the lead authority for contract tendering and is the single point of contact for all enquiries.

### **Specification**

The work specifications and the number of cuts required are detailed in the following tables.

### **Proposed Terms and Conditions**

All machinery, equipment and fuel are to be supplied by the contractor.

The contractor must hold appropriate certification for the disposal of all waste generated under this contract.

The contractor must hold appropriate third party insurance for any damage, injury or death caused by the contractor when supplying services under this contract.

The contract is to run from 1 June 2014 to 31 March 2017, subject to satisfactory performance by the contractor.

Payment will be in eight equal instalments at the end each month of the assumed growing season (April to November).

The contractor will be paid by cheque on submission of separate invoices to the Parish Clerk for each Group of Areas.

### **Tender Response Required**

A tender response form is provided at the end of this Invitation to Tender. Three costs are invited from each tenderer, one for each group of areas, reflecting current funding arrangements within this Partnership. Also, as this contract will start part way through the 2014 grass cutting season, separate costs are requested for each year of the contract.

#### **Deadline**

Tenders are to be received by the Parish Clerk at the above address no later than: **Friday 2 May 2014**.
