Other Info:	Participants will start from Newton Abbot Racecourse in groups of approximately 200 cyclists at a time. Each group will receive a short safety briefing before they depart. The first group will depart at 06:00 hrs and subsequent groups will leave with clear 5 minute intervals between them. A 'Broom Wagon' will follow the last riders around the course and will ensure all event signs are removed once all the participants have cleared that point. All participants are made aware that they will be cycling on open public roads and that they must comply with the law and highway code at all times.			
	All participants must wear a cycle helmet.			
	All participants must clearly display a personal identification number on the front of their bike. These numbers clearly identify cyclists who are participating in the event and can be used to report a rider to the Event Director should they exercise inappropriate behaviour.			
	Should a participant bring the event into disrepute, they will be banned from future events.
